SKILLS TO SUCCEED is a performative presentation and workshop where **youth build confidence, self-awareness and develop essential job skills**. This unique blend of performance, practical job skill tutorials and theatrical games, scenes, and activities are designed to engage youth through active learning. In the performance, students witness dramatized scenarios of real interview situations and then are given the opportunity to go onstage and rehearse for reality. In the workshop, trained facilitators guide youth through exercises and activities, creating an open environment that offers practical, hands on learning for the participants.

OPTION 1: PRESENTATION

Duration: 75 min (30 min presentation, 45 min intervention)

Cost: \$700 + HST = \$791

Participants: Max 150 students

OPTION 2: 2 PRESENTATIONS

(Same date, same location)

Duration: 75 min (30 min presentation, 45 min intervention) per show

Cost: \$1,100 + HST = \$1,243

Participants: Max 150 students per show

OPTION 3: PRESENTATION + WORKSHOP

Duration: 4.5 hr (3 hr workshop + 75 min presentation)

Cost: \$1,100 + HST = \$1,143

Participants: Max 150 students for show, 20 students per facilitator

OPTION 4: FULL DAY WORKSHOP

Duration: Full School day

Cost: \$1,000 + HST = \$1,130

Participants: 20 students per facilitator (3 facilitators, 60 students)
